Revision 4.....March 31st 2010

Vision: Work towards an equal balance of men/women

Code of Ethics: To conduct ourselves as ladies and gentlemen at all times and to do the right thing.

A. Games:

- 1 Follow ASA and National rules, subject to modifications
- 2 Game times 10:00, 11:15, 12:30
- 3 Seven innings, no time limit other than start time of next game
- 4 Four runs per inning, last inning unlimited
- 5 Tied game - extra inning only if there is time left before next game
- 6 Men will use AL/NL approved 12" ball & women will use 11" ball
- 7 Courtesy runners - *intended use is for handicapped, injured or recovering players only....not for just being SLOW.*
 - a Allowed from HOME but can only go to 1st base. **(Rev.2... 2-4-10)**
 - b Cannot be replaced on base with another runner unless injured .

B Duties

- 1 First game: HOME TEAM PREPARES FIELD
- 2 Officiating: (two (2) umpires, one (1) scorekeeper
 - a. Game 2 Home Team officiates First Game.
 - c. Visiting Team First Game officiates 2nd Game.
 - d. Visiting Team 2nd Game officiates 3rd Game.
- 3 Last game: HOME TEAM SECURES FIELD, stores equipment, locks clubhouse

C Managers

- 1 Shall strive for equal numbers of women on teams
- 2 *Shall draw substitutes only from other Friday teams and the Friday Placement Pool; they must bat at bottom of the order (Rev.1....11/8/09)*
- 3 Shall approve any new or replacement manager(s)
- 4 *May fill team vacancies from Placement Pool or League players*
- 5 Must file incident reports for injuries

D Players

1 Maximum THREE (3) American (Managers approved 3 & 4 rated only) per team on the field, including subs, and *using the list from the American League Placement Committee as a guideline.*

***Exception:** Current teams with FOUR A/L PLAYERS RATED 3 or 4 are grandfathered; extra A players who quit or become higher rated can't be replaced with extra A players; manager must eventually field a valid team.*

***Exception:** Players that do not play in the N/L or A/L that are not rated will be rated by the Friday League Managers. Rating a player as an A/L equivalent will be based on ; skill and safety to other players. (Rev.3...3/26/10)*

2 Every effort must be made to have a Minimum two (2) women per team

3 *There will be no penalty against a player that;*

a Quits the League

b Transfers to another Team

c Is asked to leave a Team per manager's discretion.

E Postponement of Games

One manager will be charged with the responsibility of determining if Games will be played that day due to Field Conditions. If the First Game is cancelled all games will Be cancelled. That Manager for this Session will be **Dennis Farrar**. He will notify all managers once a decision is made.

F. Sponsors

Teams supplying own uniforms and current sponsors will continue to replace uniforms on an "as needed basis". No additional fee will be charged. If a Team supplying own uniforms, or if a Sponsor wishes to discontinue sponsoring a team then the Friday League will have the option to find their own sponsor or go to the Sun City West Board and request a sponsor off their "waiting list".
